

IDT SHAREHOLDER COMMUNICATIONS POLICY

(i) Background

The company recognizes the value of providing current and relevant information to its shareholders and to empowering its shareholders through effective communication.

The Chairman, Managing Director and Company Secretary have the overall responsibility for communication with shareholders.

(ii) Electronic Communication and the Company's Website

The Company acknowledges that communicating with shareholders by electronic means, particularly through its website, is an efficient way of distributing information in a timely and convenient manner.

The Company has a website at [www.idtaus.com.au] which contains the following information relevant to shareholders:

- (a) Financial Performance:
 - (i) current and historical share price details linked to the ASX website, and
 - (ii) all recent company announcements that have been sent to the ASX announcements platform.
- (b) Corporate Information relating to:
 - (i) Board of Directors, and
 - (ii) Executive Management
- (c) Annual Reports for current and prior years
- (d) Details of the Company's general meetings, as disclosed under ASX announcements
- (e) Financial results for half and full years as disclosed under ASX announcements
- (f) Media Releases as disclosed under ASX announcements
- (g) A copy of the latest Company presentation that is used for Investor presentations or visitors to IDT.

The Company's website will be updated with material released to market as soon as practicable after confirmation of receipt by the ASX.

All website information will be continuously reviewed and updated to ensure all information is current, appropriately dated and archived.

Historical information will be archived and clearly dated to ensure users are aware that it may be out-of-date.

(iii) Written Communication and Annual Report

The Company's Annual Report is the major written communication between the Company and shareholders each year. The Company will provide the Annual Report to shareholders that have elected to receive a hard copy in a timely manner, in accordance with the requirements of the Corporations Act and the Listing Rules. Copies of the Company's Annual Report will be available from the Company's website at anytime.

(iv) Updating this Policy

This policy will be updated as and when appropriate to ensure that technological advances and additional features on the Company's website are utilized in the Company's communication with its shareholders and recognized in this policy.
